### Public Announcement Price Change Petroleum Products

The Government of St. Maarten regulates the prices of petroleum products by imposing a maximum price at which wholesalers and retailers can sell these products on St. Maarten. Currently, SOL needs restocking of their fuel and due to international developments, the prices of fuel on the world market have increased for ULG and Diesel unchanged. This has resulted in SOL having to purchase at higher price for ULG, which have been verified by the department of ETT (Economy, Transportation & Telecommunication) against International Postings. Consequently, there is a need to adjust the prices of Fuel accordingly for ULG. The public is hereby informed that as of MAY 13 2026 at 6:00 am, the **maximum consumer prices** of ULG and Diesel are as follows:
